

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

- Registration will be required for each child attending per day.
- Parents must complete the health declaration in the registration.
- Room capacity will be limited to 10 children per classroom.
- Children and staff temperatures will be checked upon arrival.
- Children with a temperature over 99.5 will not be able to attend until they have a temperature below 99.5.
- Keeping social distancing in mind, parents are asked to drop off their children and exit the building. Socializing in the hallways is discouraged.
- Please note, our indoor playground will no longer be open.
- Any child that exhibits symptoms in lieu of fever (i.e. cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste/smell, or diarrhea) will be immediately quarantined and their parent(s) will be notified to pick them up immediately. Re-entry into the program will require a negative COVID test and being symptom free for 72 hours OR they must provide a letter from their doctor verifying allergies/confirmation of another medical condition.
- Parents will be responsible for taking their child to an appropriate testing facility.
- Any staff or child who has been in contact with a symptomatic child will have a heightened screening for the remainder of the day.
- Parents will be notified of a COVID staff member or child.
- Staff are trained on how to properly sanitize and wash hands thoroughly and for the recommended 23 seconds. Our staff are also trained on how to monitor children to prevent behaviors that spread illness.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available around the Preschool area and children will be required to wash hands before meals.
